RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Application for this Research Grant will be received at any time prior to June 30th in the year in which the applicant wishes to apply.
- 2. The Bursary Committee of the B.C. Cattlemen's Association will be empowered to:
 - (a) grant this Research Grant at their discretion; and
 - (b) withhold this Research Grant in any year if there are no eligible applicants or any reason deemed good or advisable.
- 3. This Research Grant will be payable to the department of the institution through which the student is working.
- 4. The Grant Recipient must formally present the findings of their research to the BC Cattlemen's Association either verbally or in a report, illustrating how this research applies to the BC beef cattle industry.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANT

Your proposal should be no more than 5 pages, typed, single spaced. Type size must be no smaller than 12 point font. You may use illustrations but these are included in the five-page limit. To be contained within the 5 pages allowed are:

- 1. A brief plain language summary of your proposed research for public release.
- 2. An outline the objectives of your research.
- 3. A summary of the published literature relevant to your proposal.
- 4. A summary of the methods and proposed approach.
- 5. An outline the significance of the results of the proposed research to the cattle industry.
- 6. An activity schedule that shows in table form, with milestones, the activities that comprise those milestones and anticipated start and completion dates.

ENCLOSE

Along with this application, please attach:

- o a letter describing your past education and work
- a brief description (max 5pgs) of the project for which you are applying, and
- a statement from your professor or supervisor summarizing academic record and character.
